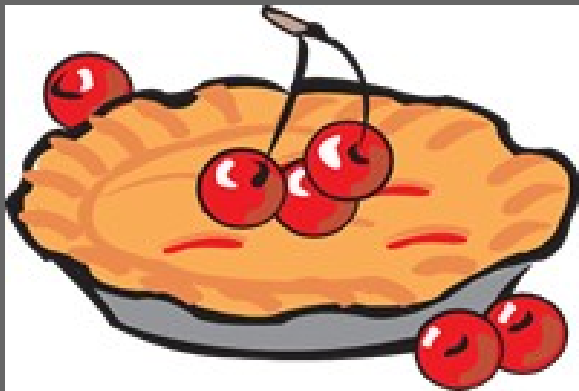

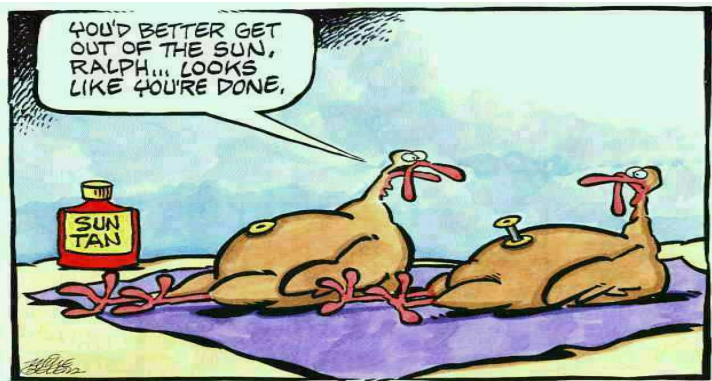
God is at work in and through you. Let's let it show! Be in prayer about it. He will give you the ideas and show you how to bring about those ideas.

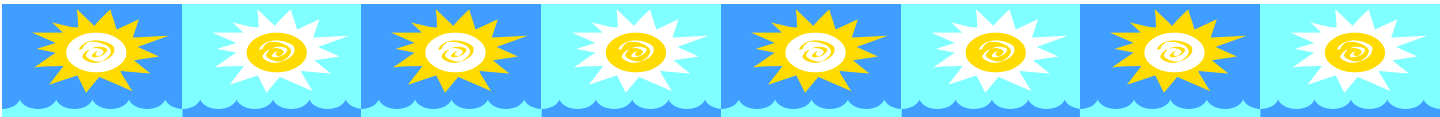

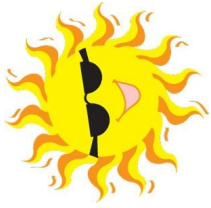

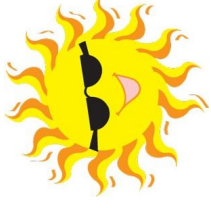
