

Admission to the 60-minute event is free and welcomes everyone.


Lifetree Café is a place where people gather for conversation about life and faith in a casual, comfortable setting. For information call 419-433-4955.

niques that are now widely used by intelligence and law enforcement agencies. In his interview, Schafer shares key indicators that signal when someone is lying.
