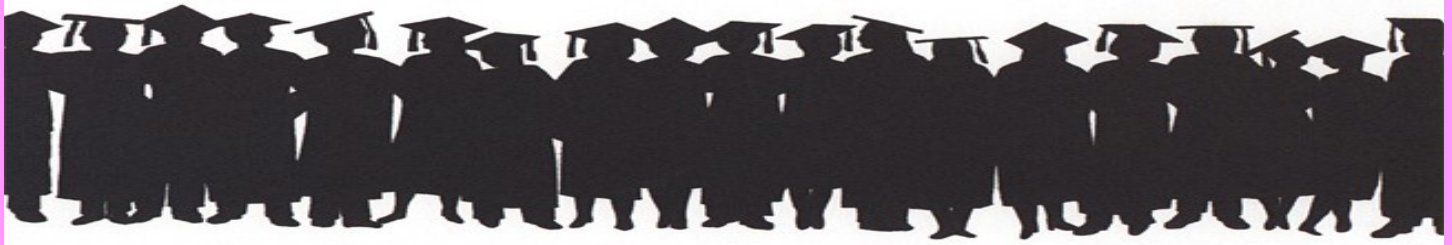


# Steeple Notes

## HELPING HANDS IN NEED OF A NEW CARGO TRUCK

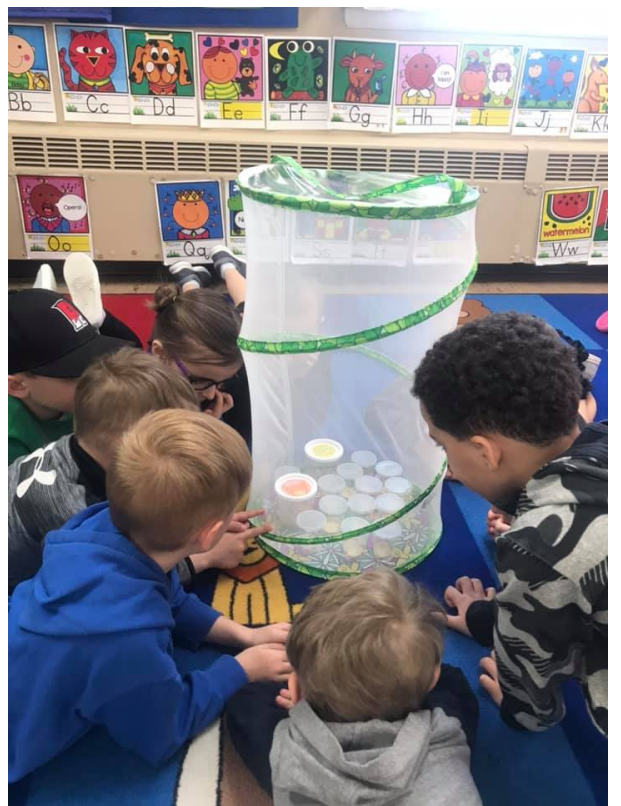
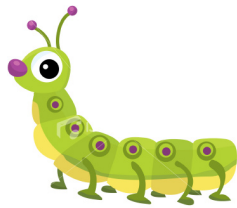

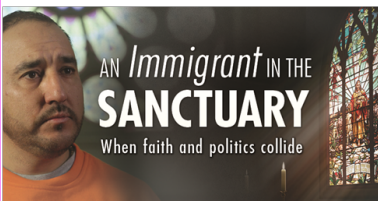

**7:00 to 8:00pm at the Christian Center behind Zion Lutheran Church (930 Main St., Huron)**

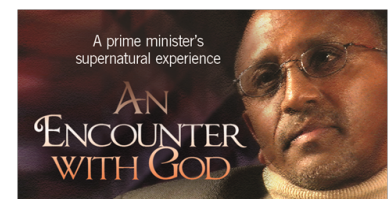


**Thursday, May 9th**
