Warm Welcome to Rev. Sara Hodsden!

Sara Hodsden was born in Berea, Ohio, the daughter of Deanna and Charles Bontempo. She is the middle child between Lora (deceased) and Charles, Jr. She was raised at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church in Olmsted Township, where her parents served as both Elders and Deacons. Sara's parents were both teachers in the Berea City and Parma School Districts.

After Sara was graduated from Berea High School, she continued her studies at Ashland University, where she earned her Bachelor of Arts in Radio and Television and Religion. She moved to Loudonville, Ohio, where she became a deejay, voice-over announcer, copywriter, ad salesperson, and accounts receivable clerk for WBZW.



While in Loudonville, she became involved

at the First Presbyterian Church in Loudonville. Her pastor suggested that she discern her call to ministry. Soon she enrolled at Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary, finally graduating in 1998 with her Master's of Divinity.

Sara first dipped her toe into ministry while in college, serving as part of the ministry team at Jackson Lake Lodge in Grand Teton National Park through A Christian Ministry in the National Parks. While serving as a night auditor for the lodge, she helped to lead Bible studies and worship services for employees and tourists. Sara continued in ministry prior to ordination at Kentucky Correctional Psychiatric Center as a chaplain, and as a student pastor at Lexington Presbyterian Church in Lexington, Indiana.

Sara met her husband, James, while in seminary. When James entered Pittsburgh Theological Seminary, Sara was ordained to pastor at New Harrisburg Presbyterian Church in Carrollton, Ohio. Sara and James served together at First Presbyterian in Vernon, Texas, and followed that up by serving two separate congregations in the Philadelphia area.

Sara and James have one son, Thomas, who is a junior at Ashland University studying Political Science and History, with an eye to entering the Foreign Service. They also have one dog, Maggie, and two cats, Edmund and Dante. When Sara isn't working, she enjoys traveling, reading, watching movies, and quilting.


