

A Message from Pastor Sara

This past Wednesday morning, when I took our dog Maggie for a walk, I went outside and thought, "Gee, I need to clean my glasses." Everything looked hazy, and I cooked on the grill the night before. But then I noticed that the air smelled like a campfire. It wasn't long before I learned that the Canadian wildfires were back.

I had an experience like this before. In 1988 I was working at Jackson Lake Lodge in Grand Teton National Park. Over in Yellowstone, which is only 30 miles or so away, fires were raging. It was a dry summer. There were 250 fires in Yellowstone and the surrounding forests, but only seven were responsible for most of the damage. During one lull in fire activity, a friend and I took a quick trip to Yellowstone to see some of the damage. It was so sad to see the charred ground where once proud lodgepole pines had stood. I wondered whether Yellowstone would ever be beautiful again.

However, nature did its thing. Lodgepole pines need fire to open their pinecones, setting their seed free. Vegetation started regrowing within days of the fire passing through. Aspen trees, which were disappearing from the park, began to spread further than ecologists ever dreamed they would.

I'm not advocating for forest fires. But it does remind me of what Paul wrote: And we know that for those who love God, all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.



There are times when I feel like the world is burning around me. The smoke from the fire burns my eyes and makes it difficult to see my way through. During those times, I need to remember the One walking through the fire with me. As long as I know He is with me, I don't need to see. I can trust that although the fire will burn, it will not consume me. And in the aftermath, new and beneficial vegetation will grow. God works it together for good. Amen.





Keep on Praying

Almost every Christian finds prayer hard at some time (or most of the time). Why is that? One of the reasons why we're tempted to give up on prayer is that we don't always receive an immediate response from God. In a world that so highly exalts instant gratification, this is a real difficulty. It's the same issue as in trying to maintain a proper exercise regimen or diet: we want to see results now, today. If our new approach does not quickly show its benefits, most of us are unlikely to persevere. Our tendency to lack endurance is one reason that Jesus told the parable about the persistent widow, who was relentless in seeking out justice from the judge. Luke makes the editorial comment that Jesus was encouraging his listeners to understand that they "ought always to pray and not lose heart" (Luke 18:1). In other words, Jesus wants us to pray-and then to keep on praying. Alistar Begg, Truth for Life, June 7, 2023
